

## **CU MEDICINE Guideline for Macro Templates and Copy Functionality in EMR Addendum –UCH**

### **Teaching Attestation Statements**

In an EMR environment a teaching physician must document by entering patient information with their own secured login and password. Secured login and passwords may not be shared with an intern/resident for purposes of creating medical documentation or teaching attestation statements.

### **CU MEDICINE Finance Audit Committee recommendation for EPIC process**

In order to support his/her contribution to a service, the teaching physician should add their own documentation by using their own secured login and password. Co-signing a resident's documentation is not sufficient to support a billable service. A teaching physician may edit the resident note for accuracy and add their contribution to the documentation by also using **“create a note”** feature. The teaching physician must also sign/date their documentation.

Providers may not use the following functions in the EMR:

- Copy/Paste/Forward
- Make Me the Author
- Edit Note
